

call an RA on duty to notify a Residence Life staff member, call University Police Department, and do not leave the person alone until help arrives.

#### Threats

The threat of physical abuse of any community member or guest thereof is forbidden. Threats, racial/sexual harassment, malicious pranks and abusive name-calling by any member of the community or guest thereof are not permitted.

#### Deadly Weapons

Possession or usage of any weapon deemed by campus authorities to be deadly is prohibited on university property and is a felony. This includes, but is not limited to guns, knives with fixed blades longer than 2 inches and the like.

#### Firearms/Explosives

Possession or use of pistols, revolvers, and firearms is prohibited and can be considered a felony. The use or misuse of air soft guns, paintball guns, and or potato guns is prohibited. Ammunition or explosives of any kind are prohibited. Fireworks are also prohibited on university property; it is a crime to possess and or detonate in the City of Marina and fireworks can be confiscated.

#### Illegal Entry

Unauthorized entry into an assignment/living space other than your own or of any affiliated university buildings or properties is prohibited.

#### Indecent Behavior

Engaging in lewd, indecent or obscene behavior within or around any university housing area or any university housing function is not permitted. Materials of a pornographic, racist or hateful nature are not permitted in public areas. These include, but are not limited to, comic strips, videos, posters, sayings, etc.

#### Open Container

Possessing an open alcoholic beverage container in a public space is illegal and prohibited on university property. An open container includes cans, bottles, cups and the like. Persons in violation of this will be required to pour out the remainder of the alcohol and will be referred to the housing conduct process.

#### Physical Abuse

Physical harm or threat of physical, emotional, verbal harm to any person, including assault/battery and physical fights is prohibited.

#### Possession of Stolen Property

Unauthorized possession of property owned by the State of California, CSUMB Foundation, Office of Residential Life, any community member or guest thereof, which has been stolen or reported as stolen is illegal and will result in disciplinary action.

#### Theft

Theft or unauthorized removal of property by the State of California, the CSUMB Foundation and its agents, Residential Life, any community member or guest thereof is prohibited.
