

housing information. It is the responsibility of the student to seek out the information from the resident advisor if the student does not attend a floor meeting.

Community Respect/Discrimination

Failure to show respect for members of the CSUMB community, the CSUMB Foundation and its agents, the Office of Residential Life, or any staff member acting in accordance with university policy is not permitted and may result in disciplinary action. Any act of prejudicial or discriminating behavior is prohibited.

Defiance

Failure to respond or adhere to the reasonable request of a university official, including representatives of the CSUMB Foundation and the Office of Residential Life (to include display of appropriate identification) is a violation of policy.

Gatherings

A social gathering of (7) or more people in any room, Residence Hall, North Quad suite, North Quad apartment, East Campus apartment, or common area without the prior approval of a professional live-in staff member is prohibited. Social gatherings that fail to comply with all relevant policies are also prohibited. A maximum of (50) people are allowed at a registered gathering in East Campus. A violation

Guests

All guests are required to comply with the Housing Regulations for Student Conduct, and other applicable university rules.

The licensee is responsible for the behavior of all guests and may be held accountable for their behavior. Guests should in no way become a nuisance to the roommate(s) or the community. The roommate(s) has the right to object to future visits and staff will mediate any concerns by the presence of guests. Guests may be asked to register with the Office of Residential Life. Students whose license has been revoked are not permitted to visit as guests.

Illegal Room Change

Moving into an apartment/room or changing apartments/rooms without the expressed approval and direction of the Office of Residential Life is a violation of policy.

Judicial Request

Failure to comply with or respond to a request to meet with CSUMB, the CSUMB Foundation and its agent or a Residential Life official to discuss alleged violations or concerns is not permitted; failure to complete sanctions rendered in response to violations may result in further disciplinary actions.

Musical Instruments

Drums, other percussion instruments, brass, woodwind, amps, subwoofers, or any amplified instruments brought into and played within the residential facilities are not allowed without prior approval by Housing Staff.
