

Security

Residence Hall Security is a shared responsibility of the University staff and students. **DO NOT PROP OPEN OR ALLOW TO BE PROPPED OPEN ANY FLOOR OR BUILDING EXIT DOOR.** Do not allow people who are not your guests onto the floor. Always carry your security card/key and lock your door. Do not loan your key to anyone and be sure to report any lost or stolen key. No student will be permitted to enter another student's room without the express consent of the students who reside in that room.

Harassment

Physical or mental harassment, which may be verbal or written, is prohibited. This includes but is not limited to sexual, racial or religious harassment, intimidation, and hazing, (refer to p. 83) prank phone calls or unwanted phone calls, etc.

Transporting Food from the Cafeteria

Meals may not be carried to the room of a student who is ill without prior approval by the Director of Residence Life or the Vice President for Student Affairs. Cafeteria dishes and other eating utensils may not be removed from the cafeteria without permission from the Director of Food Services. The temporary storage of prepared or ready-to-eat food items is permitted, provided such items are stored in sealed food containers and/or refrigerated. Kitchens are provided in all residence halls for the preparation of meals or snacks. Cooking in residence hall rooms is a violation of fire regulations and is therefore prohibited.

Windows & Window Screens

Tampering with or removing screens is prohibited. Residents will be billed if the Housing staff must replace the screens. Windows are to be closed and locked when rooms is not occupied.

Under no circumstances are windows to be used for entering or leaving residence halls. This pertains even to the case where the entrance or exit is to or from one's own room. Open windows are not to be used as a conduit to transmit music and/or noise to the community outside the residence hall.
