

residence hall tenants with the appropriate permit to park for long term in selected residence hall areas.

2.2 Violations: The university shall be authorized to create and enforce parking regulations pursuant to the California Vehicle Code, sec. 21113(a). In addition, other state and local laws relative to parking and vehicle operation shall be enforced on university property.

3.0 Residence Hall Parking: A special parking area may be set aside for those living in specified residence halls; these residents shall receive designated parking permits for use in that campus area only.

4.0 Skateboards and Roller Skates, Bicycles and Motor Scooters

4.1 Skateboards, roller skates, bicycles, and similar personal wheeled conveyances shall be prohibited throughout the campus, including streets, paths, grounds, and buildings. Riding bicycles and similar personal conveyances shall likewise be prohibited throughout the campus except on curbed streets and vehicular thoroughfares. In other places, bicyclists shall walk their bicycles and shall park them in designated parking stands and areas.

4.2 Motor scooters, motorbikes, and motorcycles shall be operated only on curbed streets and vehicular thoroughfares. They shall not be ridden or walked elsewhere on campus but shall be parked in areas designated for motorcycles and not in bicycle stands or in areas designated for bicycles.

4.3 Only motorized and nonmotorized carts, trucks, or dollies approved for operation on campus and only officially permitted motor vehicles shall be operated in areas other than curbed streets and vehicular thoroughfares.

4.4 These prohibitions shall not apply to nonambulatory persons in wheelchairs or to children in carriages or strollers.

4.5 These prohibitions shall be enforced in accordance with the San Diego State University Public Safety Code, sec. 100, and the California Vehicle Code, sec. 21113(f).

4.6 The university at principal entrances and accesses shall post appropriate signs to campus.

Public Speech and Demonstration

1.0 San Diego State University encourages free and open expression.

2.0 The Open Forum

2.1 An open forum for the free expression of ideas shall be located on the steps of Aztec Center.

2.2 The area may be used during daylight hours, spontaneously if not previously reserved, by any member of the university community possessing a university identification card; off-campus speakers may use the area upon the invitation of a campus organization and approval from the Associated Students Activities Policy Board.

2.3 The area includes an available speaker's platform and loudspeaking facilities, but the latter may not interfere with scheduled university activities.

2.4 The control of the area and the administration of the procedures for its use are in the hands of the Associated Students Activities Policy Board, which is authorized to prepare, publish, and supervise a simple and fair system for reserving and use of the area.

Smoking

(5/9/06)

1.0 Smoking shall be prohibited by San Diego State University as follows:

- a. In its buildings or leased spaces and motor pool vehicles,
- b. In outdoor areas connected to or within 25 feet of university buildings or leased space including exits, entrances, operable windows, air intake vents, stairwells, balconies, breezeways, and under overhangs and awnings.
- c. In outdoor areas within 25 feet of university-owned or -leased food establishments unless designated as smoking areas consistent with the goals of this policy and in outdoor university-owned or -leased

constructed seating areas where people are likely to congregate, unless designated as smoking areas.

d. Appropriately worded "no smoking" signs shall be placed in locations where the 20 foot rule is consistently violated and all public ash receptacles shall be placed in compliance with this policy.

2.0 The distribution of free samples of tobacco products is prohibited and the advertisement of such products anywhere on the SDSU campus is strongly discouraged.

3.0 The President shall designate a person or office to receive complaints concerning violations of this policy.

4.0 The university shall offer smoking-cessation programs for students through Student Health Services and for faculty and staff through the Center for Human Resources.

5.0 San Diego State University auxiliary organizations shall conform to this policy, except that smoking will be permitted only in the private living areas in auxiliary-owned residential buildings.

6.0 This policy shall implement CSU Executive Memorandum 02-108 in accordance with the Education Code 89030 and 89031 (Section 1994.30) and Assembly Bill 846. (12/02/03).

Space and Equipment

1.0 Entitlements for Space and Equipment

1.1 Instructional program needs and development of faculty potential shall be the criteria for defining entitlements for space and equipment.

1.2 These criteria shall be applied (a) in light of current instructional practices that have proven successful and satisfactory to faculty and students and (b) in view of untapped, yet apparent potential of each portion of the faculty for unique and creative endeavors.

1.3 Existing formulae not pertinent to the stated criteria shall be used only to define the barest minima of space and equipment to be provided within building programs.

1.4 Generally, longer-range plans of new construction shall be favored over frequent and costly programs of converting the function of a physical facility to that of another.

2.0 Faculty Office Space

2.1 Issues regarding a faculty member's office space allocation shall be negotiated by the faculty member, department chair or school director, and dean of the college.

2.2 When requested, the university shall provide available office space for full-time faculty on leave.

2.3 The university shall provide for storage and for handling of stored materials when a full-time faculty member on leave does not have access to office space.
