
COMMUNITY STANDARDS

PETS

No pets are permitted in the residence hall. Tropical fish are permitted in a single 10 gallon or smaller tank. On occasion a stray pet will be found roaming the campus. For your protection and safety, please do not touch, feed or bring it into any University building. Please contact UAPD regarding any stray animals.

PHYSICAL VIOLENCE

Using any type of physical attack or threat of attack to win a dispute, force agreement, or other behavior is strictly prohibited and subject to eviction from the Residence Halls.

POOL/SPA USE

You are expected to follow all posted rules at each of the swimming pools and spas. Failure to follow the posted rules can result in a transfer to a building without a pool or spa. There are no lifeguards at any of our pools. If you choose to swim, you do so at your own risk.

POSTING POLICY

Some bulletin boards in the halls may be used by students for posting notices to publicize authorized University-sponsored events. All materials for posting or display must have the approval of the Hall Director and comply with Community Standards for civility and fire safety, and that they will be affixed to surfaces in a manner that will do neither temporary nor permanent damage to the surfaces to which they are affixed.

PRANKS

Pranks are not allowed in the residence halls as they often cause physical and/or psychological damage.

PRESENCE DURING A VIOLATION

In an attempt to clarify the rights and responsibilities of any University student or person regarding their presence in a room, residence hall or where a violation of any University policy is occurring, the following policy applies:

1. You have the right and responsibility to leave the room and/or area immediately.
2. You have the right and responsibility to help implement the conditions of this policy and, in particular, to report such violation(s) to hall staff.
3. The presence of any student in any room, building, and/or facility or University premises where a violation of University policy is occurring will ordinarily constitute that student or students to be in violation of University policy.

QUIET HOURS/NOISE

Quiet hours (the absence of loud noise or distractions) are in effect every evening, from 10 p.m. to 10 a.m. Sunday through Thursdays and Midnight to 10:00am on Saturday and Sunday in each hall/apartment. At other times, you are expected to exercise good judgment with respect to making excessive noise. During final exams quiet hours are in effect twenty-four hours a day. Do not make or
