

Noise/Courtesy Hours

Engaging in loud activities, either inside or outside, which violate the following provisions:

24 Hour Courtesy Hours

At any time, a level of noise, which may be, deemed an undue disturbance by any member of the community is a violation of the 24 hour courtesy policy.

Quiet Hours:

Sun	Thurs	10pm	8am
Fri	Sat	12 midnight	10am

Creating noise that is audible outside of one's room during quiet hours is prohibited.

All outside areas, including the courtyards, basketball and volleyball courts, must adhere to the Quiet Hours policy.

In addition, the Housing Community honors 24-Hour Quiet hours prior to finals in both the fall and spring. Information will be posted to provide the dates for 24-hour Quiet Hours each semester.

Overnight Stays

Overnight guests are allowed only with the approval of roommate(s), for any period of time. Overnight guests are defined as any non-licensee staying in the Residence Hall, North Quad, or East Campus between 12:00 AM and 7:00 AM. No more than two persons may occupy the unit as overnight guests at any time. The total number of days a guest can stay is not to exceed 14 days during the

term of this license. The Licensee is responsible for the behavior of any guests. This policy is to be followed in conjunction with Part 22 of the License Agreement.

Parking

Licensee or their guests are prohibited from driving in or around residential community courtyards. Licensee or guests are permitted to park only in designated spaces with parking permit.

The Office of Residential Life is not responsible for any parking violations that may be incurred by licensee or their guests. Parking permits are available for sale at the Campus Service Center (building 47), the University Center parking area, or in parking lots 12 and 18.

Pets

Only fish in aquariums (up to a maximum of a ten (10) gallon tank) or fish in a bowl are permitted in the residence halls and North Quad. Pet such as dogs, cats, birds, gerbils, turtles, hamsters, rabbits, frogs, snakes, iguanas, etc., are not permitted in the Residence Halls or North Quad. The only exception to this is an animal specially used for the sight, hearing, or mobility impaired student. In these cases the resident/owner of the animal will assume full responsibility for the care and upkeep, as well as any damages, cleaning fees and extermination of the room/suite.

Posting

The distribution or posting of any material not approved by The Office of Residential Life is prohibited.
