
Thank you for your interest in starting a club for the 2014-2015 academic year. Following a complete review of your prospective club's proposal and upon recommendation of the Club Coordination Council, a branch of the undergraduate Student Government, I regret to inform you that Students for Child-Oriented Policy will not be recognized by the Student Activities Office as a University student club.

In evaluating a proposal, approval is based is on several things. We consider the general purpose of a club, uniqueness to campus, proposed activities, a clear constitution, a strong understanding of budget planning, projected membership, opportunity for membership among other things. In addition, groups which will have a relationship with another department on campus will need to secure support from that department.

The Club Coordination Council indicated that the mission of your club closely mirrored that of other undergraduate student clubs on campus which served the intended interests of this club. As such, the Club Coordination Council felt there was not a need for another similar type club. You are encouraged to contact the Club Coordination Council's Social Service Division to learn about collaborating with the existing clubs working towards your mutual goals.
