Hi Sam,

I wanted to reach out and let you know that we cannot approve TPUSA's reactivation registration at this time. [redacted] who I have cc'd, is an affiliated faculty member and is not eligible to serve as an organization advisor. The reason for this is because there is no guarantee that affiliated faculty will be coming back semester to semester, so in order to avoid organizations having to constantly scramble to find a new advisor to replace them, we have the policy that it must be either a full-time faculty or staff member that serves as the primary advisor. Affiliated faculty are welcome to still serve as a secondary advisor if they wish to, we just need a full time person for the primary advisor role.

Your organization also needs three students in leadership positions, and KJ and Patty are not eligible to be a part of the executive board as KJ is taking a semester off and Patty has since graduated. Students need to be active students in order to be a part of student organizations and hold leadership positions. Turning Point can continue to operate as an independent student organization if they wish to for the semester.

Due to this, all social media platforms, graphics, and organization email accounts will need to be updated so that they do not contain Emerson's brand or likeness, meaning that the use of Emerson's name cannot be in any graphics, org email accounts, social media account names, or EmConnect titles associated with the org. Independent student organizations are also not eligible to do instagram takeovers on the official Emerson instagram account because of these policies.
