I wanted to reiterate our appreciation for Caltech's response to our letter of December 10, 2021, explaining that Caltech will review the event funding guidelines issued by its Graduate Student Council that determine whether to approve requests to fund student group events based on the university's "values of diversity, equity and inclusion."

Now that more than three months have passed, I am checking to see if Caltech has implemented new guidelines that ensure funding requests are considered in a viewpoint-neutral manner. Again, FIRE would be happy to assist in reviewing and amending GSC's guidelines to ensure consistency with Caltech's commitment to students' expressive rights.

We request an update regarding Caltech's review of the event funding guidelines by April 8, 2022.
