Dear Dominick Dotson:

Due to the seriousness of alleged Student Code violations on April 6, 2022, I am temporarily suspending you from Northern Michigan University until all Student Code charges against you are adjudicated. Kash Dhanapal (227-1700, vdhanapa@nmu.edu) will contact you when he is ready to begin the student conduct process. The office is open Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Your eligibility to return to NMU in the future will not be considered until all Student Code issues are resolved.

During a temporary suspension, a student shall be denied access to University housing, to the campus (including classes), and/or all other university activities or privileges for which the student might otherwise be eligible. With the semester ending in approximately three weeks, I am allowing you to remain in your campus apartment and attend your Winter 2022 classes until the Student Code charges against you are adjudicated. If there are any further alleged violations of the Student Code during the conduct process these privileges will be rescinded immediately.

The situation will continue to be investigated and charges against you will be adjudicated promptly under the provisions of the *Student Code*. You can review the *Student Code*, located in the Student Handbook, at www.nmu.edu/studenthandbook. Again, Kash Dhanapal (227-1700, vdhanapa@nmu.edu) will contact you when it is time to begin the student conduct process. He can also answer any questions you have.
