Thank you for your inquiry. Legal education requires asking difficult questions and asking them often. I believe that our community and our nation need more conversation about important issues, not less. I have repeatedly described lowa Law's diversity of faculty viewpoints to be one of the College of Law's greatest strengths. Law Schools are also guided by ABA Accreditation Standards. Pursuant to ABA Accreditation Standard 206, it is incumbent on me, as a dean, to encourage people to engage diverse people and views. Despite the headline, I did not mandate a "pledge," but simply encouraged faculty introspection as to this question. While faculty are not required to respond, the question has contributed to healthy discussion.
