Parker is not alleged to have violated the UMC photo and film policy and therefore that is not part of the ongoing Student Conduct & Conflict Resolution process.

Your questions regarding the UMC photo and film policy are appreciated. CU Boulder regularly reviews its policies across campus, and we will review the UMC photo and film policy as part of our standard review process.

I want to reiterate that CU Boulder is committed to supporting open dialogue, free expression and the essential role of professional and student journalism on campus. Our Office of Strategic Relations and Communications (SRC) has several staff dedicated to supporting journalists, whether student or professional journalists, who cover stories on and about our campus.
