Dear Mr. Lukianoff:

I am writing in response to FIRE's follow-up query about security costs for an event sponsored by a student group — Liberty, Objectivism, Greed, Individualism and Capitalism (L.O.G.I.C.).

As I said in my letter of February 26<sup>th</sup>, addressed to Tara E. Sweeney, Senior Program Officer of FIRE, security costs will be covered by the university. However, as with all events, the costs for staff that perform "house staff" type services such as ushering, monitoring doors and checking wristbands are charged to registered student organizations. For the currently scheduled L.O.G.I.C. event, the costs for the services of Contemporary Services Corporation will be charged to L.O.G.I.C. because they are administrative in nature.
