
Dear Ms. Evans:

Mr. Warner requests a rehearing of his case in front of the SSCA or SRC in conjunction with Section 2, Article III, Subsection 7(b) of the University of North Dakota Code of Student Life. New information, relevant to his proceedings, has recently become available. This request is based on new information obtained through the investigation by the Grand Forks Police Department and the North Dakota State's Attorney's Office, which is relevant to the alleged violation.

Specifically, Mr. Warner intends to present new testimony from Detective Vigness of the Grand Forks Police Department regarding the inconsistencies in [REDACTED]'s statements to police and the testimony of new witnesses uncovered by Det. Vigness's investigation of the allegations against Mr. Warner. Mr. Warner also intends to present evidence of [REDACTED]'s current arrest warrant, for filing a False Report to Law Enforcement, issued on May 17, 2010, in relation to this case. (Please see enclosed.) This information was not available during Mr. Warner's initial hearing. Please accept this letter as a formal request for a rehearing through Section 2, Article III, Subsection 7(b) of the Code of Student Life.
